





The number of JP trademark applications in 2011 was 108,060, down of 4.8% from 2010.


The number of International Applications for Trademark Registration based on Protocol Relating to the Madrid Agreement (hereinafter referred to as "International Application") increased by 14.7% compared with 2010. Especially the application from OHIM (by 39.1%), China (by 23.4%), and German (by 18.3%) increased.

Trademark applications excluding International Application decreased by 6.9% from 2010. It seems to be the result of the economic recession in recent years and the applications may have been carefully selected.



The average number of designated classes per application was 1.73 in 2011. It has been slightly increasing compared to the number in 2010.






According to the statistics concerning the trademark applications filed by foreigners in 2011, it constitutes 22% of the whole trademark applications. It increased by 19 % from 2009.

The number of trademark applications in 2011 from US, EU, China and Korea was 19,015. It increased by 11 % from the figure in 2010 (17,108). The proportion of the applications from China in the whole applications to Japan has increased by 6.8% compared with 5.9% in 2009.

The waiting period from the date of application to an issuance of the first action (FA term) was 4.8 months in 2011, due to the promotion for streamlining of trademark examination. SA term, that is the period from the date of application to an issuance of decision after the first examination result, was 10.8 month.

The number of trademark registrations has been shifting around a hundred thousand level.
